PUBLIC NOTICE CONCERNING MOSQUITO CONTROL

March / April 2009

The Butte County Mosquito and Vector Control District hereby gives notice that it intends to continue to control mosquitoes throughout the District as necessary to protect the public's health. The District's Integrated Pest Management (IPM) Program includes the use of physical control to remove the breeding source (if applicable), public education, biological control, as well as, aircraft and ground applications of control materials as authorized by the California Health and Safety Code sections governing Mosquito and Vector Control Districts.

The District will continue to make larval and adult mosquito control applications of U.S. EPA and CA. EPA registered mosquito control materials using ground and aircraft equipment to control mosquito larvae and adults as necessary anywhere within the District to protect people within the District from excessive mosquito populations and/or disease risks.

District personnel will on occasion enter onto private property within the District to make inspections for larval breeding or the presence of adult mosquitoes. These inspections and any necessary control measures are made under the authority of California Health and Safety Code Section 2000 et. seq.

The District may also be conducting field surveys to help determine the presence and potential public health risk of West Nile virus, and other mosquito transmitted diseases, Lyme disease, Bubonic Plague and Hantavirus in various parts of the County.
